- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.001, Education Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) The legislature shall provide state funding in an amount
 8 that constitutes at least 55 percent of the cost of maintaining and
 9 operating the public school system.
- 10 (d) The legislature may not recapture more than 35 percent

 11 of a school district's revenue from ad valorem taxes for the

 12 maintenance of public schools in the district. In this subsection,

 13 "recapture" means a system under which a school district is

 14 required to use a portion of the district's local ad valorem tax

 15 revenue for the benefit of public schools in this state other than
- 17 (1) the remittance of revenue to a state officer or 18 agency for redistribution to other school districts;

those in the district, including:

- 19 <u>(2) the remittance of revenue to another school</u>
 20 <u>district for use by that district; and</u>
- 21 (3) the use of revenue to administer and operate a 22 shared services program between the school district raising the 23 revenue and one or more other school districts.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2008.
