- 6 and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER G. AQUATIC LIFE FROM PROHIBITED AREAS; CONSUMPTION
- 8 WARNINGS
- 9 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 436, Health and Safety
- 10 Code, is amended by adding Section 436.092 to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 436.092. WARNING SIGNS NEAR BOAT RAMPS AND PIERS. The
- department shall post and maintain signs in the two most widely used
- 13 languages in the area at all public boat ramps providing access to
- 14 an area of fresh water or at fishing piers for an area of salt water
- that is affected by a f<u>ish or shellfish consumption advisory or fish</u>
- or shellfish consumption ban issued by the department advising the
- 17 public of the existence of the ban or advisory.
- 18 SECTION 3. The Department of State Health Services shall
- 19 begin posting signs required by Section 436.092, Health and Safety
- 20 Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable, but not later
- 21 than January 1, 2008.
