## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the authority of the Texas Lottery Commission to
3	establish an Internet lottery game program.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 466.002, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subdivision (11) to read as follows:
7	(11) "Private Internet agent" means a person that has
8	contracted with the commission to operate the Internet lottery game
9	program.
10	SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 466, Government Code, is
11	amended by adding Sections 466.257, 466.258, and 466.259 to read as
12	follows:
13	Sec. 466.257. INTERNET LOTTERY GAME PROGRAM. (a) The
14	commission shall establish and maintain an Internet lottery game
15	program that allows an eligible person to purchase lottery tickets
16	from a private Internet agent through the Internet. The commission
17	shall adopt the rules necessary to administer the program. The
18	other provisions of this chapter applicable to the sale of lottery
19	tickets apply to the sale of tickets under the program, except that
20	Section 466.152(d) does not apply to the sale of tickets by the
21	private Internet agent under this section.
22	(b) The commission shall select a private Internet agent, in

accordance with the standards and qualifications described in

Section 466.258(a), to operate a real-time and secure payment

- option system for the Internet lottery game program.
- 2 (c) The commission shall offer for purchase over the
- 3 Internet and through an electronic distribution channel tickets for
- 4 each Lotto lottery game that involves a drawing and each
- 5 multijurisdiction lottery game offered by the commission.
- 6 (d) A person who purchases a ticket through the Internet
- 7 lottery game program shall be notified electronically of the amount
- 8 of any prize the person wins in connection with that ticket. A prize
- 9 in an amount less than \$600 must be deposited directly into the
- winner's bank account. The payment of a prize in an amount of \$600
- or more may be made only by the director.
- 12 (e) The commission shall determine which games may be played
- online and shall limit the persons authorized to purchase tickets
- online to only eligible residents of this state in compliance with
- the federal Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006.
- 16 (f) The commission by rule and in compliance with the
- 17 federal Unlawful Internet Gambling Enforcement Act of 2006 shall
- develop a procedure to verify that a person is 18 years of age or
- 19 older before the person may establish an individual online lottery
- 20 account and purchase lottery tickets through the Internet lottery
- game program. The commission shall adopt standards to prevent the
- 22 unauthorized use of individual online lottery accounts.
- 23 (g) The commission by rule may establish limitations on the
- amount or number of monthly purchases that may be made through any
- 25 individual online lottery account.
- Sec. 466.258. OPERATION OF INTERNET LOTTERY GAME PROGRAM.
- 27 (a) The commission shall contract with a private Internet agent to

- 1 offer for purchase from the private Internet agent lottery tickets
- 2 through the. In addition to any other reasonable qualifications
- 3 required by the commission, the private Internet agent must:
- 4 (1) demonstrate:
- 5 (A) extensive experience in handling secure
- 6 Internet financial transactions on a real-time basis; and
- 7 <u>(B) the ability to maintain an Internet website</u>
- 8 in compliance with the best industry standards related to security
- 9 and the protection of personal information;
- 10 (2) possess a demonstrable ability to create and
- 11 maintain an Internet website and subsites with a high volume of use
- that meet or exceed electronic security standards in the electronic
- 13 payment or transfer industry such as a Statement on Auditing
- 14 Standards No. 70 Type II review; and
- 15 (3) submit to the commission a history of the agent's
- 16 <u>financial accountability and compliance with generally accepted</u>
- 17 accounting principles.
- (b) The private Internet agent, with the cooperation and
- 19 approval of the commission, shall develop procedures to establish
- 20 individual online lottery accounts and unique identification
- 21 <u>numbers for each player purchasing tickets from a private Internet</u>
- 22 agent through the Internet and to verify the age and address of the
- 23 player and the payment method used by the player.
- 24 (c) The private Internet agent:
- 25 (1) may collect a reasonable transaction fee from each
- 26 player who establishes an individual online lottery account and
- 27 purchases a lottery ticket through that account; and

- 1 (2) is entitled to an incentive bonus for selling a
- 2 winning ticket as approved and provided by this chapter and
- 3 commission rule.
- 4 (d) The private Internet agent shall deliver to the
- 5 commission the money collected from Internet transactions for the
- 6 sale of a lottery ticket under the Internet lottery game program
- 7 within 48 hours of the agent's receipt of the money. The agent
- 8 shall:
- 9 (1) deliver to the commission records of each
- 10 transaction on a real-time basis or as otherwise required by the
- 11 commission; and
- 12 (2) deduct the agent's fees before delivering the
- 13 money to the commission.
- 14 (e) Notwithstanding Section 466.151(a), the private
- 15 Internet agent is not required to be licensed as a sales agent to
- 16 sell lottery tickets under the Internet lottery game program.
- 17 Sec. 466.259. INDIVIDUAL LOTTERY ACCOUNT. (a) A person who
- 18 <u>is eligible to purchase a lottery ticket through the Internet</u>
- 19 lottery game program may create a secure individual online lottery
- 20 account that is accessible through the Internet or by other secure
- 21 <u>electronic means and may apply for an account:</u>
- (1) online through a commission-approved Internet
- 23 website by filling out the electronic application form on the
- 24 website; or
- 25 (2) through a sales agent or the private Internet
- agent by filling out an application form in person and presenting to
- 27 the agent a valid Texas driver's license with a current address or

- 1 <u>an official state-issued identification card.</u>
- 2 (b) A sales agent or the private Internet agent shall
- 3 provide an application form for an individual online lottery
- 4 account to a person who requests an application. The sales agent or
- 5 private Internet agent shall verify that the person applying for
- 6 the account is 18 years of age or older. The agent may retain an
- 7 application processing fee in an amount established by commission
- 8 rule.
- 9 (c) The application form must be approved by the commission
- or the commission's approved private Internet agent. A completed
- 11 <u>application must include:</u>
- 12 (1) the applicant's name, address, age, and driver's
- 13 license number or the number of an official state-issued
- 14 identification card;
- 15 (2) an e-mail address for the applicant;
- 16 (3) the last four digits of the applicant's social
- 17 security number; and
- 18 (4) any other information required by the commission
- 19 or the private Internet agent.
- 20 (d) A sales agent in accordance with commission rules shall
- 21 <u>deliver to the private Internet agent through an electronic method</u>
- 22 <u>or the United States Postal Service all applications for individual</u>
- online lottery accounts received by the sales agent.
- (e) The private Internet agent shall verify over the
- 25 Internet through a connection with the Department of Public Safety
- the name, age, address, and driver's license number or the number of
- 27 an official state-issued identification card of any person applying

- 1 for an individual online lottery account. The department shall
- 2 cooperate with the commission and the private Internet agent to
- 3 provide the connection for purposes of this subsection.
- 4 (f) An individual online lottery account may not be
- 5 activated until the person applying for the account accesses the
- 6 Internet lottery game program website and follows the activation
- 7 and funding procedure established by the commission. Each account
- 8 holder must be issued electronically a unique individual online
- 9 lottery account access number designed to prevent other persons
- 10 from accessing the person's account.
- 11 (g) The commission shall develop a method by which a person
- 12 who has activated and funded an individual online lottery account
- 13 may purchase lottery tickets from a private Internet agent through
- 14 the Internet by using public or private computer.
- SECTION 3. Section 466.251(c), Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (c) The overall estimated odds of winning a prize in a
- 18 particular lottery game must be printed or displayed on each ticket
- 19 and prominently displayed in association with the sale of lottery
- 20 products. The estimate must be based on reasonable projections and
- 21 past experience.
- SECTION 4. Section 466.303(a), Government Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- 24 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a person who is
- 25 not a sales agent, [or the private
- 26 Internet agent commits an offense if the person intentionally or
- 27 knowingly sells a ticket.

- 1 SECTION 5. Section 466.304(a), Government Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 (a) A person other than the private Internet agent commits
- 4 an offense if the person sells a ticket at a location other than the
- 5 location of a sales agency.
- 6 SECTION 6. Section 466.305, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(a-1) Selling a ticket to another person through the</u>
- 9 Internet lottery game program authorized under Section 466.257 does
- 10 not constitute selling a ticket by extending credit to the person
- 11 for purposes of Subsection (a).
- 12 SECTION 7. Section 466.3052(a), Government Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 (a) A person commits an offense if the person intentionally
- or knowingly sells a ticket and the person accepts anything other
- 16 than the following as payment for the ticket:
- 17 (1) United States currency;
- 18 (2) a negotiable instrument in the form of a check that
- meets the requirements of Section 3.104, Business & Commerce Code;
- 20 (3) a debit made through a financial institution debit
- 21 card;
- 22 (4) a coupon or voucher issued by the commission for
- 23 purposes of purchasing a lottery ticket; [or]
- 24 (5) a mail order subscription on a mail order
- subscription form authorized by the commission; or
- 26 (6) payment through an electronic transaction
- 27 authorized by the commission for the purchase of a ticket under the

- 2 SECTION 8. (a) The change in law made by this Act to Chapter
- 3 466, Government Code, applies only to an offense committed on or
- 4 after the effective date of this Act. For purposes of this section,
- 5 an offense is committed before the effective date of this Act if any
- 6 element of the offense occurs before the effective date.
- 7 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 8 Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 9 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 9. Not later than November 1, 2007, the Texas
- 11 Lottery Commission shall adopt the rules and procedures necessary
- 12 to implement the Internet lottery game program in accordance with
- 13 Chapter 466, Government Code, as amended by this Act.
- 14 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 15 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 16 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 17 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 18 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
