The remainder of the total delivery 12 fees collected may be expended at the discretion of the commission. 13 (1) Any and all unexpended balances carried forward from the previous fiscal year as of August 31, 2008 from appropriations made 14 from the Alternative Fuels Research and Education account and 15 collected pursuant to Natural Resources Code, Section 113.243 shall 16 be dedicated to and used exclusively for the purpose of consumer 17 18 rebates and shall be carried forward into the following fiscal year and remain differentiated as consumer rebate funds in the 19 Alternative Fuels Research and Education Account 101 pursuant to 20 21 Natural Resources Code, Section 113.2435. 22 (2) These carry over funds shall not be considered in 23 determining the amount of Available Funds for the current fiscal

year as cited in Section 113.2435(c)(5) of the Texas Natural

1 Resources Code which establishes the requirement of using not more 2 than 50% of funds available for the consumer rebate program in the 3 Account 101 fund in any fiscal year. 4 (3) Carry over funds are not to impede with the statutory maximum parentage requirement language concerning not more then 50% 5 6 of funds available to be used in any category. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10
