1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the establishment of a student outcomes pilot program
1-10 by Alamo Community College District.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
1-13 amended by adding Section 130.0105 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 130.0105. ESTABLISHMENT OF STUDENT OUTCOMES PILOT
1-15 PROGRAM BY ALAMO COMMUNITY COLLEGE. (a) Alamo Community College
1-16 District shall establish a pilot program to collect and analyze
1-17 statistical data regarding student outcomes at the college in order
1-18 to:

1-19 (1) facilitate accountability of the college by
1-20 determining the efficacy of instruction by the college and
1-21 examining the transition of students to four-year institutions of
1-22 higher education; and

1-23 (2) further ongoing education excellence initiatives
1-24 by the college.

1-25 (b) This section expires September 1, 2017.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
