- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 1603, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1603.2035 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1603.2035. PROVISIONAL INSTRUCTOR LICENSE. (a) The
- 8 department shall issue a provisional license as an instructor to an
- 9 applicant who has completed at least three years of current
- 10 verifiable experience as a licensed operator.
- 11 (b) The department shall issue an instructors license to a
- 12 provisional license holder who has completed the required hours of
- 13 <u>instruction in cosmetology in a commission-approved training</u>
- 14 program under Section 1602.255.
- 15 (c) A provisional instructor license issued under this
- section is valid for one year from the date the license is issued. A
- 17 provisional instructor license may be renewed not more than two
- 18 <u>times.</u>
- 19 (d) Not more than 50 percent of the instructors at a beauty
- 20 <u>culture school or other place of business where cosmetology is</u>
- 21 taught may hold a provisional instructor license under this
- 22 section.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
