1-7 Amend H.B. No. 4007 (House Engrossed Version) by striking  
1-8 SECTION 3 of the bill (page 1, line 31) and substituting the  
1-9 following appropriately numbered SECTION:

1-10 SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. This Act takes effect immediately if it  
1-11 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each  
1-12 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.  
1-13 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate  
1-14 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the county courts at law in Nueces County.

1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 25.1802(e), Government Code, is amended  
1-20 to read as follows:

1-21 (e) The judges [~~judge~~] of the county courts at law in Nueces  
1-22 County [~~Court at Law No. 1, 2, or 3 of Nueces County may be paid, and~~  
1-23 ~~the judge of County Court at Law No. 4 and the judge of County Court~~  
1-24 ~~at Law No. 5 of Nueces County]~~ shall each be paid[~~7~~] an annual  
1-25 salary equal to the amount that is \$1,000 less than the salary paid  
1-26 by the state to a district judge in the county. The salaries shall  
1-27 be paid in the same manner and from the same fund as prescribed by  
1-28 law for the county judge.

1-29 SECTION 2. Sections 25.1802(f) and (g), Government Code,  
1-30 are repealed.

1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
