2 (y) The El Paso Council of Judges shall order the transfer 3 of criminal misdemeanor cases to the county criminal courts at law [County Criminal Courts No. 1 and No. 2] from time to time to 4 5 equalize the criminal misdemeanor dockets of the statutory county courts for the efficient operation of the court system and the 6 7 effective administration of justice. In determining the court to 8 which a case is transferred, the council shall give preference to a county criminal court at law that is required to give preference to 9 certain cases under Subsection (z). 10

(z) The County Criminal Courts No. 1, [and] No. 2, No. 3, and <u>No. 4</u> have the criminal jurisdiction provided by <u>this section and</u> <u>other</u> law for <u>statutory</u> county courts <u>in El Paso County</u> and appellate jurisdiction in appeals of criminal cases from justice courts and municipal courts in the county as provided by Article 45.042, Code of Criminal Procedure. <u>The County Criminal Court No. 4</u> shall give preference to cases prosecuted under:

18 (1) Section 22.01, Penal Code, in which the victim is a
19 person whose relationship to or association with the defendant is
20 described under Chapter 71, Family Code; and

(2) Section 25.07, Penal Code.

SECTION 3. The County Criminal Court at Law No. 3 of El Paso County, Texas, and the County Criminal Court at Law No. 4 of El Paso County, Texas, are created September 1, 2007.
