- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 712, Acts of the 71st Legislature,
- 6 Regular Session, 1989, is amended by adding Section 1A to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 1A. NAME OF DISTRICT. The name of the Emerald
- 9 Underground Water Conservation District is changed to the Crockett
- 10 County Groundwater Conservation District.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 2, Chapter 712, Acts of the 71st
- 12 Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 2. DEFINITION. In this Act, "district" means the
- 14 Crockett County Groundwater [Emerald Underground Water]
- 15 Conservation District.
- SECTION 3. Section 7, Chapter 712, Acts of the 71st
- 17 Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended by adding Subsection
- 18 (a-1) and amending Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- 19 (a-1) Notwithstanding Sections 49.001 and 49.002(b), Water
- 20 Code, Section 49.052, Water Code, applies to a director of the
- 21 district.
- 22 (d) Directors [Permanent directors other than initial
- 23 permanent directors] serve staggered four-year terms, with the
- 24 terms of two or three directors expiring December 1 of each

- 1 even-numbered year.
- 2 (e) Each director must qualify to serve as director in the
- 3 manner provided by Section 36.055 [Sections 51.078 and 51.079],
- 4 Water Code.
- 5 SECTION 4. Chapter 712, Acts of the 71st Legislature,
- 6 Regular Session, 1989, is amended by adding Sections 10A and 10B to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 10A. DIRECTOR ELECTIONS. On the uniform election date
- 9 in November of each even-numbered year, the appropriate number of
- 10 <u>directors shall be elected.</u>
- 11 Sec. 10B. LOCATION OF DISTRICT ELECTIONS. A district
- 12 election may be held at any location in Crockett County.
- SECTION 5. Sections 7(b) and (c) and 10, Chapter 712, Acts
- of the 71st Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, are repealed.
- SECTION 6. Notwithstanding Section 7(d), Chapter 712, Acts
- of the 71st Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, as amended by this
- 17 Act:
- 18 (1) the terms of the directors of the Emerald
- 19 Underground Water Conservation District who were elected in May
- 20 2005 expire December 1, 2008; and
- 21 (2) the terms of the directors of the Emerald
- 22 Underground Water Conservation District who are elected in May 2007
- 23 expire December 1, 2010.
- 24 SECTION 7. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 25 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 26 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 27 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,

- officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 2 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 3 Government Code.
- 4 (b) The governor has submitted the notice and Act to the
- 5 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 6 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 7 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
- 8 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
- 9 within the required time.
- 10 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 11 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 12 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 13 and accomplished.
- SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
