7	Sec. 54.1511. APPOINTMENT. The Commissioners Court of
8	McLennan County may appoint one or more magistrates to perform the
9	duties authorized by this subchapter.
10	Sec. 54.1512. QUALIFICATION. To be eligible for
11	appointment as a magistrate, a person must be a resident of McLennar
12	County, Texas.
13	Sec. 54.1513. JUDICIAL IMMUNITY. A magistrate has the same
14	judicial immunity as a district judge.
15	Sec. 54.1514. POWERS. (a) Subject to the standing orders
16	of the Commissioners Court of McLennan County, a magistrate has the
17	same powers as a magistrate under Chapters 16 and 17, Code of
18	Criminal Procedure, or under any other laws of this state with
19	regard to setting bail, issuing required warnings, or conducting
20	examining trials.
21	(b) The county judge has the same powers as a magistrate.
22	(c) A magistrate may administer oaths for any purpose.
