6	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 8247 to read as follows:

9	Sec. 8247.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Board" means the board of directors of the

12	(2) "Director" means a member of the board.
13	(3) "District" means the York Valley Municipal Utility
14	<u>District.</u>
15	Sec. 8247.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
16	municipal utility district in Guadalupe County created under and
17	essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI,
18	Texas Constitution.
19	Sec. 8247.003. CONFIRMATION ELECTION REQUIRED. If the
20	creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation
21	election as provided by Section 49.102, Water Code, before
22	September 1, 2014:
23	(1) the district is dissolved September 1, 2014,
24	except that the district shall:

1	(A) pay any debts incurred;
2	(B) transfer to Guadalupe County any assets that
3	remain after the payment of debts; and
4	(C) maintain the organization of the district
5	until all debts are paid and remaining assets are transferred; and
6	(2) this chapter expires September 1, 2014.
7	Sec. 8247.004. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a)
8	All land and other property included in the district will benefit
9	from the improvements and services to be provided by the district.
10	(b) The district is created to accomplish:
11	(1) the purposes of a municipal utility district as
12	provided by general law; and
13	(2) to the extent authorized by Section 52, Article
14	III, Texas Constitution, the construction, acquisition,
15	improvement, maintenance, or operation of macadamized, graveled,
16	or paved roads, or improvements in aid of those roads.
17	Sec. 8247.005. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
18	district is initially composed of the territory described by
19	Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter.
20	(b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
21	the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
22	field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
23	does not affect the district's:
24	(1) organization, existence, or validity;
25	(2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
26	for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
27	interest on a bond;

1	(3) right to impose or collect an assessment or tax; or
2	(4) legality or operation.

4	SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS
5	Sec. 8247.051. DIRECTORS; TERMS. (a) The district is
6	governed by a board of five directors.
7	(b) Except as provided by Section 8247.053, directors serve
8	staggered four-year terms.
9	Sec. 8247.052. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. On the uniform
10	election date in May of each even-numbered year, the appropriate
11	number of directors shall be elected.
12	Sec. 8247.053. INITIAL DIRECTORS. (a) The initial board
13	consists of:
14	(1) Greg Hammonds;
15	(2) Carole Baker;
16	(3) Jimmy Kull;
17	(4) Marcy Steward; and
18	(5) William Meyer.
19	(b) Unless the initial board otherwise agrees, the initial
20	directors shall draw lots to determine which two directors shall
21	serve until the first regularly scheduled election of directors and
22	which three directors shall serve until the second regularly
23	scheduled election of directors.

25	SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES
26	Sec. 8247.101. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
27	DUTIES. (a) The district has the powers and duties provided by the

1	general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
2	applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
3	Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
4	(b) The district has the powers and duties necessary to
5	accomplish the purposes for which the district is created.
6	Sec. 8247.102. ROAD PROJECTS. (a) To the extent authorized
7	by Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may
8	construct, acquire, improve, maintain, or operate macadamized,
9	graveled, or paved roads, or improvements in aid of those roads.
10	(b) A road project must meet all applicable standards,
11	regulations, and ordinances of the municipality or county in whose
12	jurisdiction the district is located.
13	Sec. 8247.103. DIVISION OF DISTRICT. (a) The district may
14	be divided into two new districts only if the district:
15	(1) has no outstanding bonded debt; and
16	(2) is not imposing ad valorem taxes.
17	(b) Any new district created by the division of the district
18	has all the powers and duties of the district.
19	(c) Any new district created by the division of the district
20	may not, at the time the new district is created, contain any land
21	outside the area described by Section 2 of the Act creating this
22	<u>chapter.</u>
23	(d) The board, on its own motion or on receipt of a petition
24	signed by the owners of a majority of the assessed value of real
25	property in the district according to the most recent certified
26	appraisal roll for the county in which the district is located, may
27	adopt an order dividing the district.

1	(e) An order dividing the district shall:
2	(1) name each new district;
3	(2) include the metes and bounds of each new district;
4	(3) appoint temporary directors for each new district;
5	and
6	(4) provide for the division of assets and liabilities
7	between each new district.
8	(f) On or before the 30th day after the adoption of an order
9	dividing the district, the district shall file the order dividing
10	the district with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and
11	record the order in the real property records of the county in which
12	the district is located.
13	(g) Any new district created by the division of the district
14	shall hold a confirmation and directors' election as required by
15	Section 49.102, Water Code.
16	(h) Any new district created by the division of the district
17	must hold an election in the manner provided by Chapters 49 and 54,
18	Water Code, to obtain voter approval before the district may impose
19	a maintenance tax or issue bonds payable wholly or partly from ad
20	valorem taxes.
21	Sec. 8247.104. FIREFIGHTING AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL
22	SERVICES. (a) The district may establish, operate, and maintain,
23	or contract with another political subdivision for the joint
24	operation of, a fire department to perform all firefighting and
25	emergency medical services in the district in accordance with
26	Subchapter L, Chapter 49, Water Code.
27	(b) The district may issue bonds or impose a mandatory fee,

1	with voter approval, for financing a fire plan approved in
2	accordance with Section 49.351, Water Code, including the
3	construction and purchase of necessary buildings, facilities,
4	land, and equipment and the provision of an adequate water supply.

6	SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
7	Sec. 8247.151. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES OR BONDS. (a) The
8	district may issue, without an election, bonds and other
9	obligations secured by revenue or contract payments from any source
10	other than ad valorem taxation.
11	(b) The district must hold an election in the manner
12	provided by Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code, to obtain voter approval
13	before the district may impose an operation and maintenance tax or
14	issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes.
15	Sec. 8247.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
16	authorized at an election held under Section 8247.151, the district
17	may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in
18	the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code.
19	(b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
20	exceed the rate approved at the election.

22	SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS
23	Sec. 8247.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
24	OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may issue bonds or other obligations
25	payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, impact fees,
26	revenue, grants, or other district money, or any combination of
27	those sources, to pay for any authorized district purpose.

H.B. No. 4055 (b) The district may not issue bonds to finance projects 1 2 authorized by Section 8247.102 unless the issuance is approved by a vote of a two-thirds majority of the voters of the district voting 3 4 at an election called for that purpose. (c) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance 5 6 projects authorized by Section 8247.102 may not exceed one-fourth 7 of the assessed value of the real property in the district. Sec. 8247.202. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time bonds payable 8 9 wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes are issued: (1) the board shall impose a continuing direct annual 10 ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, for each year 11 12 that all or part of the bonds are outstanding; and (2) the district annually shall impose an ad valorem 13 14 tax on all taxable property in the district in an amount sufficient 15 to: (A) pay the interest on the bonds as the interest 16 17 becomes due; (B) create a sinking fund for the payment of the 18 principal of the bonds when due or the redemption price at any 19 earlier required redemption date; and 20 (C) pay the expenses of imposing the taxes. 21 SECTION 2. (a) The legal notice of 13 the intention to 14 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 15 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 16 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 17 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 18 19 Government Code.

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
Environmental Quality.

(c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 23 24 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the and the speaker 25 lieutenant governor, of the house of 26 representatives within the required time.

(d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this

state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled and accomplished.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
