8	Sec. 286.101. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
9	to Denton County.
10	Sec. 286.102. ROAD USE FEE AUTHORIZED. (a) The
11	Commissioners Court of Denton County may impose a road use fee on an
12	entity that is authorized to do business in this state and drills
13	gas wells in Denton County.
14	(b) The amount of a fee imposed under Subsection (a) must
15	be:
16	(1) based on the costs of county road maintenance made
17	necessary by the use of those roads by the entity, vehicles owned
18	and operated by the entity, or vehicles owned by another person or
19	entity and operated for the benefit of the entity; and
20	(2) calculated according to the following structure:

This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 19
