1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the authority of the Las Lomas Municipal Utility
1-11 District No. 4 of Kaufman County and the Kaufman County Water
1-12 Control and Improvement District No. 1 to undertake road projects.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 8138.102, Special
1-15 District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-16 (a) To the extent authorized by Section 52, Article III,
1-17 Texas Constitution, the district may construct, acquire, improve,
1-18 maintain, or operate macadamized, graveled, or paved roads [~~or~~
1-19 ~~turnpikes~~], or improvements in aid of those roads [~~or turnpikes,~~
1-20 ~~inside the district~~].

1-21 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 9002.101, Special
1-22 District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-23 (a) To the extent authorized by Section 52, Article III,
1-24 Texas Constitution, the district may construct, acquire, improve,
1-25 maintain, or operate macadamized, graveled, or paved roads [~~or~~
1-26 ~~turnpikes~~], or improvements in aid of those roads [~~or turnpikes,~~
1-27 ~~inside the district~~].

1-28 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
