8 THENCE, North 34°11'55" West, 586.07 feet along the northeasterly 9 line of a called 11.057 acre tract conveyed to the Houston Audubon 10 Society by Deed recorded under Clerk's File No. 8243154 of the 11 Montgomery County Official Public Records of Real Property, and a 12 southwesterly line of said 1,023.05 acre tract to a 3/4-inch iron 13 pipe inside a 1-inch iron pipe found for an angle point in the 14 southwesterly line of the herein described parcel;

THENCE, North 34°38'25" West, 848.51 feet along the northeasterly line of a called 20.1 acre tract conveyed to Diana Dushkin by Deed recorded under Clerk's File No. 8328156 of the Montgomery County Official Public Records of Real Property, and a southwesterly line of said 1,023.05 acre tract to an angle point in the southwesterly line of the herein described parcel;

THENCE, along the northeasterly line of a called 998.5360 acre tract conveyed to Midway Spring Trails Partners, L.P. by Deed recorded under Clerk's File No. 2000-081148 of the Montgomery County Official Public Records of Real Property the following courses and distances:

18 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 19 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 20 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 21 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 22 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 23 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 24 Government Code.

(b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
Environmental Quality.

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 1 (c) 2 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the 3 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of 4 representatives within the required time.

5 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this 6 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect 7 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled 8 and accomplished.

9

SECTION 4. The legislature finds that:

10 (1) the Montgomery County Municipal Utility District 11 No. 120, as created by Chapter 8267, Special District Local Laws 12 Code, as added by this Act, is not officially created until 13 confirmed by a majority of the voters of the district voting at an 14 election held for that purpose;

15 (2) securing the consent of political subdivisions to 16 the creation of the district before the introduction or passage of 17 this Act may be impractical because of the uncertainties of the 18 legislative process; and

(3) the constitutional requirement for the district's compliance with the provisions of the general laws relating to the consent of political subdivisions to the creation of the district and the inclusion of land within the district is satisfied if that consent is secured before the date and hour of canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the confirmation election.

25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
