16	Sec. 8267.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
17	municipal utility district in Montgomery County created under and
18	essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI,

17	Sec. 8267.005. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
18	district is initially composed of the territory described by
19	Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter.
20	(b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
21	the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
22	field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
23	does not affect the district's:
24	(1) organization, existence, or validity;
25	(2) right to issue any type of bond for the purposes
26	for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
27	interest on a bond;

1	(3) right to impose or collect an assessment or tax; or
2	(4) legality or operation.

- 17 Sec. 8267.052. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. On the uniform
- 18 election date in May of each even-numbered year, the appropriate
- 19 number of directors shall be elected.
- 20 [Sections 8267.053-8267.100 reserved for expansion]
- SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES
- Sec. 8267.101. MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT POWERS AND
- 23 <u>DUTIES.</u> (a) The district has the powers and duties provided by the
- 24 general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 54, Water Code,
- 25 applicable to municipal utility districts created under Section 59,
- 26 Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
- 27 (b) The district has the powers and duties necessary to

- 1 <u>accomplish the purposes for which the district is created.</u>
- Sec. 8267.102. ROAD PROJECTS. (a) To the extent authorized
- 3 by Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may
- 4 acquire, construct, or finance a road that meets the criteria or
- 5 requirements for a thoroughfare, arterial, or collector road of the
- 6 county in which the road is located or the municipality in whose
- 7 corporate limits or extraterritorial jurisdiction the road is
- 8 located or improvements in aid of that road.
- 9 (b) A road project must meet all applicable standards,
- 10 regulations, and ordinances of the municipality or county in whose
- 11 jurisdiction the district is located.
- 12 Sec. 8267.103. RECREATIONAL FACILITIES; LIMIT ON EMINENT
- 13 DOMAIN POWER. (a) In this section, "recreational facilities" and
- 14 "develop and maintain" have the meanings assigned by Section
- 15 <u>49.462</u>, Water Code.
- 16 (b) The district may develop and maintain recreational
- 17 facilities.
- 18 <u>(c) The district may not, for the development or maintenance</u>
- 19 of a recreational facility, acquire by condemnation land, an
- 20 easement, or other property inside or outside the district.
- Sec. 8267.104. COMPLIANCE WITH MUNICIPAL CONSENT
- 22 ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS. Subject to the limitations of Section
- 23 <u>54.016, Water Code, the district shall comply with all applicable</u>
- 24 requirements of any ordinance or resolution adopted by the
- 25 governing body of the municipality that consents to the creation of
- 26 the district or to the inclusion of lands within the district.

11	Sec. 8267.152. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
12	authorized at an election held under Section 8267.151, the district
13	may impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in
14	the district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code.
15	(b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
16	exceed the rate approved at the election.

18	SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS
19	Sec. 8267.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER

22	revenue, grants, or other district money, or any combination of
23	those sources, to pay for any authorized district purpose.
24	Sec. 8267.202. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. (a) The district
25	may not issue bonds to finance projects authorized by Section
26	8267.102 unless the issuance is approved by a vote of a two-thirds
27	majority of the voters of the district voting at an election called

- 6 THENCE, North  $75^{\circ}21'56''$  East, 1587.09 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod
- 7 set (with cap stamped "Montgomery and Associates") for a northerly
- 8 corner of the herein described parcel beginning a curve to the
- 9 right;
- 10 THENCE, along the arc of said curve to the right having a radius of
- 11 1950.00 feet, an arc length of 433.26 feet, through a delta of
- $12^{\circ}43'49$ ", and a chord bearing North  $81^{\circ}43'51$ " East, 432.37 feet to a
- 13 5/8-inch iron rod set (with cap stamped "Montgomery and
- 14 Associates") for a northerly corner of the herein described parcel;
- 15 THENCE, North 88°05'45" East, 245.40 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING,
- 16 CONTAINING 545.93 acres (23,780,883 square feet) of land in
- 17 Montgomery County, Texas.
- 18 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 19 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 20 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 21 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 24 Government Code.
- 25 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 26 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 27 Environmental Quality.

- 1 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 2 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 3 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 4 representatives within the required time.
- 5 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 6 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 7 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 8 and accomplished.
- 9 SECTION 4. The legislature finds that:
- 10 (1) the Montgomery County Municipal Utility District
- 11 No. 120, as created by Chapter 8267, Special District Local Laws
- 12 Code, as added by this Act, is not officially created until
- 13 confirmed by a majority of the voters of the district voting at an
- 14 election held for that purpose;
- 15 (2) securing the consent of political subdivisions to
- 16 the creation of the district before the introduction or passage of
- 17 this Act may be impractical because of the uncertainties of the
- 18 legislative process; and
- 19 (3) the constitutional requirement for the district's
- 20 compliance with the provisions of the general laws relating to the
- 21 consent of political subdivisions to the creation of the district
- 22 and the inclusion of land within the district is satisfied if that
- 23 consent is secured before the date and hour of canvassing the
- 24 returns and declaring the results of the confirmation election.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
