(b) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance projects authorized by Section 8267.102 may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the real property in the district. Sec. 8267.203. BONDS FOR RECREATIONAL FACILITIES. If

authorized at an election under Section 8267.151, the district may issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes to pay for the development and maintenance of recreational facilities. Sec. 8267.204. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time bonds payable

wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes are issued:

(1) the board shall impose a continuing direct annual ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount, for each year that all or part of the bonds are outstanding; and (2) the district annually shall impose an ad valorem
