3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 4, Chapter 997, Acts of the 78th
5	Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 4. BOUNDARIES. The <u>Buffalo Bayou Management District</u>
7	[district] includes all the territory contained in the following
8	described area:
9	POINT OF BEGINNING at the intersection of the center line of Allen
10	Parkway and the west boundary of the Houston Downtown Management
11	District, then west along the center line of Allen Parkway to the
12	west boundary of Montrose right-of-way, then south along the west
13	boundary of Montrose right-of-way to the south boundary line of
14	West Clay right-of-way, then west along the south boundary line of
15	West Clay right-of-way to the intersection of the west boundary of
16	Shepherd Drive right-of-way. Then north along the west boundary of
17	Shepherd Drive right-of-way to the intersection of the south
18	boundary of the Buffalo Bayou. Then west along the south boundary
19	of the Buffalo Bayou to the intersection of the south boundary of
20	the Buffalo Bayou and the west boundary of Westcott Street
21	right-of-way. Then north along the west boundary of Westcott
22	Street right-of-way to the intersection of the north boundary of
23	Feagan Street right-of-way. Then east along the north boundary of
24	Feagan Street right-of-way until the intersection of the north

boundary of Feagan Street right-of-way and the west boundary of 1 2 Jackson Hill Street right-of-way. Then north along the west boundary of Jackson Hill Street right-of-way to the intersection of 3 4 the north boundary of Raymond Street right-of-way. Then west along the north boundary of Raymond Street right-of-way until the 5 6 intersection of the east boundary of Heights Boulevard 7 right-of-way. Then north along the east boundary of Heights 8 Boulevard right-of-way to the intersection of the south boundary of Washington Avenue right-of-way. Then east along the south boundary 9 of Washington Avenue right-of-way to the intersection of the west 10 boundary line of the Washington Cemetery. Then south along the west 11 boundary line of the Washington Cemetery to the intersection of the 12 north boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way, then east along 13 the north boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way to the 14 15 intersection of the west boundary line of the Houston Downtown 16 Management District, then south along the west boundary line of the Houston Downtown Management District to the center line of Allen 17 Parkway, the POINT OF BEGINNING [POINT OF BEGINNING at the 18 intersection of the west boundary line of the Houston Downtown 19 Management District and the north boundary of Memorial Drive 20 right-of-way, then west along the north boundary of Memorial Drive 21 right-of-way to the north boundary of Memorial Drive's Heights 22 North exit ramp, then northwest along the north boundary of 23 24 Memorial Drive's Heights North exit ramp to the east boundary of 25 Heights boulevard right-of-way, then west across Heights Boulevard from the east boundary of Heights Boulevard right-of-way to 26 west boundary of the Heights Boulevard right-of-way, then south 27

along the west boundary of Heights boulevard right-of-way to the north boundary of Memorial Drive's Memorial West entrance ramp, then southwest along the north boundary of Memorial Drive's Memorial West entrance ramp to the northern boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way, then west along the northern boundary line of Memorial Drive right-of-way to the west boundary line of Shepherd Drive right-of-way, then south along the west boundary line of Shepherd Drive right-of-way to the centerline of West Dallas, then east along the centerline of West Dallas to the intersection of the west boundary of Montrose Boulevard right-of-way and the centerline of West Dallas, then south along the west boundary line of Montrose Boulevard right-of-way to the south boundary line of U.S. Highway 59 and the west boundary line of Montrose Boulevard right-of-way, then in an easterly direction from said intersection along the south boundary line of U.S. Highway 59 to the intersection of the west boundary line of the Main Street right-of-way and then proceeding from said intersection in northwesterly direction along the boundary line of the west Main Street right-of-way paralleling the boundary line of the Greater Southeast Management District to the intersection of the boundary line of the south Portland Street right-of-way and the boundary line of the west Main Street right-of-way, being the southern boundary line of the Midtown Management District, then proceeding from said intersection in generally a northeasterly direction the boundary line parallels the Midtown Management District boundary line to the intersection of the west boundary line of the US Hwy right-of-way and the north boundary line of the Cleveland Street

1 SECTION 7. The legislature finds that:

Environmental Quality;

- (1) proper and legal notice of the intention to introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished by the constitution and laws of this state, including the governor, who has submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 10 (2) the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has 11 filed its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, 12 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives 13 within the required time;
- 14 (3) the general law relating to consent by political 15 subdivisions to the creation of districts with conservation, 16 reclamation, and road powers and the inclusion of land in those 17 districts has been complied with; and
- (4) all requirements of the constitution and laws of this state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been fulfilled and accomplished.
- SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
