Section 12, Chapter 772, Acts of the 78th 10 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows: 11 FEES [FEE ON GROUNDWATER TRANSFERRED OUT OF Sec. 12. 12 DISTRICT]. Unless exempt under this Act or Chapter 36, Water Code, 13 the board [The district] may establish by schedule and impose: 14 15 (1) a production fee under Section 36.205, Water Code; 16 (2) an [a reasonable] export fee for [on] groundwater 17 transferred out of the district in an amount not to exceed 150 percent of the maximum wholesale water rate charged by the City of 18 19 Houston; and 20 (3) other fees as authorized by Chapter 36, Water 21 Code. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 23 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
