A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the powers and financing of the Brazoria County 3 Groundwater Conservation District. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 772, Acts of the 78th 5 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 2. DEFINITIONS [DEFINITION]. In this Act: 7 8 (1) "District" [7 "district"] means the Brazoria County Groundwater Conservation District. 9 (2) "Board" means the district's board of directors. 10 SECTION 2. Section 11, Chapter 772, Acts of the 78th 11 12 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows: Sec. 11. LIMITATIONS ON DISTRICT POWERS. (a) The district 13 14 may not for any purpose: impose a tax of any type [property tax]; 15 (1) exercise the power of eminent domain; 16 (2) (3) acquire land; 17 (4) issue or sell bonds; or 18 (5) purchase, sell, transport, or distribute surface 19 water or groundwater. 20 21 (b) For a new or existing water well on private property that serves only a single-family dwelling [is] used only for 22 domestic [personal or agricultural] purposes [in Brazoria County, 23 or to otherwise benefit the land on which the well is located], the 24

2	(1) [impose a tax of any type;
3	[(2)] assess or collect a fee of any type; or
4	(2) $[(3)]$ require that a meter be placed on the well.
5	(c) For a new or existing water well used only for
6	agriculture, as that term is defined by Section 36.001, Water Code,
7	the district may not:
8	(1) assess or collect a fee of any type; or
9	(2) require that a meter be placed on the well.
10	SECTION 3. Section 12, Chapter 772, Acts of the 78th
11	Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, is amended to read as follows:
12	Sec. 12. <u>FEES</u> [FEE ON GROUNDWATER TRANSFERRED OUT OF
13	DISTRICT]. Unless exempt under this Act or Chapter 36, Water Code,
14	the board [The district] may <u>establish by schedule and</u> impose <u>:</u>
15	(1) a production fee under Section 36.205, Water Code;
16	<u>(2) an</u> [a reasonable] export fee <u>for</u> [on] groundwater
17	transferred out of the district in an amount not to exceed 150
18	percent of the maximum wholesale water rate charged by the City of
19	Houston; and
20	(3) other fees as authorized by Chapter 36, Water
21	Code.
22	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
25	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
26	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
