A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the creation of the East Denton County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1; providing authority to impose a tax and issue bonds; granting the power of eminent domain.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subtitle I, Title 6, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Chapter 9029 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 9029. EAST DENTON COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT

DISTRICT NO. 1

SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Sec. 9029.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

(2) "Director" means a board member.

(3) "District" means the East Denton County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1.

Sec. 9029.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a water control and improvement district in Denton County created under and essential to accomplish the purposes of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.

Sec. 9029.003. CONFIRMATION ELECTION REQUIRED. If the creation of the district is not confirmed at a confirmation election held under Section 9029.023 before September 1, 2011:

(1) the district is dissolved September 1, 2011, except that the district shall:

1 (A) pay any debts incurred;

2 (B) transfer to Denton County any assets that
3 remain after the payment of debts; and

4 (C) maintain the organization of the district
5 until all debts are paid and remaining assets are transferred; and

6 (2) this chapter expires September 1, 2014.

7 Sec. 9029.004. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
8 district is initially composed of the territory described by
9 Section 2 of the Act creating this chapter.

10 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
11 the Act creating this chapter form a closure. A mistake made in the
12 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
13 does not affect:

14 (1) the organization, existence, or validity of the
15 district;

16 (2) the right of the district to impose taxes;

17 (3) the validity of the district's bonds, notes, or
18 other indebtedness; or

19 (4) the legality or operation of the board.

21 SUBCHAPTER A-1. TEMPORARY PROVISIONS

22 Sec. 9029.021. TEMPORARY DIRECTORS. (a) On or after
23 September 1, 2007, a person who owns land in the district may submit
24 a petition to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality
25 requesting that the commission appoint as temporary directors the
26 five persons named in the petition.

27 (b) The commission shall appoint as temporary directors the

1 five persons named in the first petition received by the
2 commission.

3 (c) If a temporary director fails to qualify for office, the
4 commission shall appoint a person to fill the vacancy.

5 (d) Temporary directors serve until the earlier of:

6 (1) the date directors are elected under Section
7 9029.023; or

8 (2) the date this chapter expires under Section
9 9029.003.

10 Sec. 9029.022. ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING OF TEMPORARY
11 DIRECTORS. As soon as practicable after all the temporary
12 directors have qualified under Section 49.055, Water Code, the
13 temporary directors shall meet at a location in the district
14 agreeable to a majority of the directors. If a location cannot be
15 agreed upon, the meeting shall be at the Denton County Courthouse.
16 At the meeting the temporary directors shall elect officers from
17 among the temporary directors and conduct any other district
18 business.

19 Sec. 9029.023. CONFIRMATION AND INITIAL DIRECTORS'
20 ELECTION. The temporary directors shall hold an election to
21 confirm the creation of the district and to elect five directors as
22 provided by Section 49.102, Water Code.

23 Sec. 9029.024. INITIAL ELECTED DIRECTORS; TERMS. The
24 directors elected under Section 9029.023 shall draw lots to
25 determine which two shall serve until the first regularly scheduled
26 election of directors under Section 9029.052 and which three shall
27 serve until the second regularly scheduled election of directors.

1 Sec. 9029.025. EXPIRATION OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter
2 expires September 1, 2014.

4 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

5 Sec. 9029.051. DIRECTORS; TERMS. (a) The district is
6 governed by a board of five directors.

7 (b) Directors serve staggered four-year terms.

8 Sec. 9029.052. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. On the uniform
9 election date in May of each even-numbered year, the appropriate
10 number of directors shall be elected.

11 [Sections 9029.053-9029.100 reserved for expansion]

12 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

13 Sec. 9029.101. WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
14 POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has the powers and duties provided
15 by the general law of this state, including Chapters 49 and 51,
16 Water Code, applicable to water control and improvement districts
17 created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution,
18 including the powers provided by Section 51.331, Water Code.

19 Sec. 9029.102. ROAD PROJECTS. (a) To the extent authorized
20 by Section 52, Article III, Texas Constitution, the district may
21 construct, acquire, improve, maintain, or operate macadamized,
22 graveled, or paved roads, or improvements in aid of those roads,
23 inside the district.

24 (b) A road project must meet or exceed all applicable
25 construction standards and regulatory ordinances of each
26 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
27 jurisdiction the district is located. If the district is located

1 outside the extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, a road
2 project must meet or exceed all applicable construction standards
3 and regulatory ordinances of each county in which the district is
4 located.

6 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS

7 Sec. 9029.151. TAX TO REPAY BONDS. The district may impose
8 a tax to pay the principal of or interest on bonds issued under
9 Section 9029.201.

10 [Sections 9029.152-9029.200 reserved for expansion]

11 SUBCHAPTER E. BONDS

12 Sec. 9029.201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE BONDS AND OTHER
13 OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may issue bonds or other obligations
14 as provided by Chapters 49 and 51, Water Code, to finance the
15 construction, maintenance, or operation of projects under Sections
16 9029.101 and 9029.102.

17 (b) The district may not issue bonds to finance projects
18 authorized by Section 9029.102 unless the issuance is approved by a
19 vote of a two-thirds majority of district voters voting at an
20 election called for that purpose.

21 (c) Bonds or other obligations issued or incurred to finance
22 projects authorized by Section 9029.102 may not exceed one-fourth
23 of the assessed value of the real property in the district.

24 SECTION 2. The East Denton County Water Control and
25 Improvement District No. 1 initially includes all the territory
26 contained in the following area:

27 BEING a parcel or tract of land situated in the F. Wilkerson Survey,

4 the County of Denton, Texas, and being all of those tracts of land
5 described to Mike A. Myers Investment Holdings, LTD. by deeds

7 Clerk File No. 05-93340, Deed Records, Denton County, Texas, and
8 being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

17 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
18 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
19 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
20 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
21 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
22 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
23 Government Code.

24 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
25 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
26 Environmental Quality.

27 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed

1 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
2 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
3 representatives within the required time.

4 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
5 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
6 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
7 and accomplished.

8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
