1-15 AN ACT

1-16 relating to the creation of a county court at law in Van Zandt
1-17 County.

1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-19 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 25, Government Code, is
1-20 amended by adding Sections 25.2361 and 25.2362 to read as follows:

1-21 Sec. 25.2361. VAN ZANDT COUNTY. Van Zandt County has one
1-22 statutory county court, the County Court at Law of Van Zandt County.

1-23 Sec. 25.2362. VAN ZANDT COUNTY COURT AT LAW PROVISIONS. In
1-24 addition to the jurisdiction provided by Section 25.0003, a county
1-25 court at law in Van Zandt County has, concurrent with the district
1-26 court, the jurisdiction provided by the constitution and general
1-27 law for district courts, except that the county court at law does
1-28 not have jurisdiction in capital felony cases.

1-29 SECTION 2. The County Court at Law of Van Zandt County is
1-30 created January 1, 2011.

1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2011.
