CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, It is desirable to adopt by resolution various rules and policies regarding the operation of joint committees to supplement, and reconcile differences between, the senate and house rules of procedure; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the 80th Legislature of the State of Texas, in accordance with the proclamation of the lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of representatives creating the Joint Select Committee on the Operation and Management of the Texas Youth Commission, hereby adopt additional rules and policies regarding the operation of the joint select committee; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the co-chairs of the joint select committee, acting jointly and within two weeks of the proclamation, prepare and present to the presiding officers a proposal for budget and staffing; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the co-chairs be directed to use to the greatest extent possible the existing staff and administrative resources of committee members, standing committees, officers of the senate and house, and legislative service agencies; and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the joint select committee have authority to issue process as provided by Sections 301.024-301.027, Government Code, provided that any motion for the issuance of process must receive the record vote of at least two-thirds of the committee members present and voting and at least two-thirds of the members of

- 1 the committee representing each house, a quorum being present; and,
- 2 be it further
- RESOLVED, That the joint select committee have authority to
- 4 meet in executive session for the limited purpose of examining a
- 5 witness or deliberating, considering, or debating a decision,
- 6 provided that no decision may be made or voted on except in a
- 7 meeting that is open to the public; and, be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee have all other
- 9 powers and duties provided to special committees by Subchapter B,
- 10 Chapter 301, Government Code, and the senate and house rules of
- 11 procedure; and, be it further
- RESOLVED, That the Texas Legislative Council be authorized to
- 13 reimburse the senate and house of representatives for expenses
- 14 incurred by members of the senate and house for transportation,
- 15 meals, lodging, and incidentals for travel on official business of
- 16 the joint select committee; and, be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That the final report of the joint select committee
- 18 be approved by a majority of the voting membership of the committee
- 19 and a majority of the members of the committee representing each
- 20 house; dissenting voting members may attach statements to the final
- 21 report subject to any limitations specified in the rules adopted by
- the committee; and, be it further
- 23 RESOLVED, That the joint select committee expires on January
- 24 13, 2009.
