CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, Mark R. Warren of Plainview has completed his term  
2 as president of the Texas Association of Insurance and Financial  
3 Advisors for 2005-2006, and he has served his colleagues well in  
4 leading one of the nation's largest state associations of insurance  
5 agents and financial services professionals; and

6           WHEREAS, The co-owner of Morgan-Eaves Insurance Agency, Mr.  
7 Warren is a Life Underwriter Training Council Fellow, and he  
8 brought 30 years of experience to his role as TAIFA's 81st  
9 president; and

10           WHEREAS, His prominence in the insurance industry is  
11 underscored by his many contributions to TAIFA, which include  
12 service as president of the Plainview Association of Insurance and  
13 Financial Advisors, five years as a TAIFA regional director,  
14 committed involvement in TAIFAPAC, and multiple years on the board

22 remembrance of this fine young Texan, who was an organ donor, the  
23 Warren family has actively advocated for organ donation; moreover,

1 Retreat for campus organizations at Texas Tech University in an  
2 effort to create a safer environment for students; and

3 WHEREAS, Mark R. Warren has distinguished himself as a leader  
4 in his professional field, and his hard work and dedication have  
5 contributed greatly to the goals and achievements of TAIFA; now,
