1 WHEREAS, The death of Bishop Rhymes H. Moncure, Jr., on 2 August 19, 2006, has brought great sadness to his many friends and 3 admirers; and

WHEREAS, Bishop Moncure reached people's hearts through his warm manner and generosity of spirit; he preferred hugging to shaking hands, made time to visit people in crisis, and began a ritual of washing the feet of new pastors during ordination services; and

9 WHEREAS, Born in Oakland, California, Bishop Moncure 10 received advanced degrees in ministry and spent 32 years as a parish 11 pastor before his election as bishop in 2000; he first served in 12 that role in Nebraska, before heading the 160,000-member North 13 Texas Conference, which included supervising 325 congregations; 14 and

15 WHEREAS, In addition to his church responsibilities, this 16 notable leader was a Southern Methodist University trustee and a 17 director of the United Methodist Church Board of Global Ministries, 18 in which capacity he chaired the Africa, Europe, and Middle East 19 Section; and

20 WHEREAS, Bishop Moncure has left behind an immeasurable 21 legacy of service to others, and his memory will long inspire those 22 who shared in his love and friendship; now, therefore, be it
