CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Legislature of the State of Texas is pleased to
recognize the Texas Juvenile Probation System and declare April 24,
2007, as Texas Juvenile Probation Day at the State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, The State of Texas and county governments are partners in providing one of the most progressive juvenile probation systems in the nation; and

7 WHEREAS, Overseen by the Texas Juvenile Probation 8 Commission, the Texas Juvenile Probation System is comprised of 169 9 community-based probation departments which serve youth and 10 families in all 254 counties in the state; and

18 WHEREAS, The juvenile probation departments handle 97 19 percent of the referrals of juveniles to the juvenile justice 20 system each year through the efforts of more than 7,100 certified 21 juvenile probation and detention officers; and

22 WHEREAS, These dedicated men and women are represented by the 23 Juvenile Justice Association of Texas, which promotes advocacy for 24 Texas children by providing quality juvenile services through
