CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Texas Legislature has a long history of 2 venerating military units by designating memorial highways in their 3 honor, and the exemplary service demonstrated by Texas members of the 75th Ranger Regiment of the United States Army is certainly 4 5 worthy of such a tribute; and WHEREAS, Known to many as the United States Army Rangers, the 6 75th Ranger Regiment is an elite special operations force that can 7 trace its lineage to the American Revolutionary War; since the 8 beginning of World War II, the regiment has distinguished itself in 9 14 battles and wars, including the Battle of Normandy, the Battle of 10 the Bulge, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, Operation Enduring 11 12 Freedom, and Operation Iraqi Freedom; and 13 WHEREAS, Earning dozens of medals and citations, Texas members of the 75th Ranger Regiment have served their country with 14 extraordinary heroism in battle; U.S. Army Corporal William M. 15 Amundson, Jr., of The Woodlands, for example, was a member of the 16 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment, when he was killed in action in 17 eastern Afghanistan on October 19, 2004, and the sacrifices 18 Corporal Amundson made on the battlefield earned him the Bronze 19 Star, the Purple Heart, and the Meritorious Service Medal; and 20
