3 family and friends of Mary Celeste Morrison Fasken Marcum of
4 Midland, who passed away on April 4, 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in San Antonio to Frank B. Morrison and Mary
6 Peters Morrison on May 6, 1919, Celeste Marcum attended San Antonio
7 schools and Texas Woman's College; and

8 WHEREAS, A Midland resident for most of her life, Mrs. Marcum
9 was a valued congregant of First Presbyterian Church and an active
10 member of the community; she served on the board of governors for
11 both Big Brothers Big Sisters and High Sky Children's Ranch, and
12 she gave of her time and talents to Midland College and Trinity
13 Towers; Mrs. Marcum was also a founding member of the Dollar
14 Scholars Investment Club and a former president of the Junior
15 League of Midland; and

16 WHEREAS, With her first husband, Murray Fasken, she
17 established an endowed chair to recognize and reward outstanding
18 teaching in the College of Liberal Arts at Texas A&M University; and

19 WHEREAS, After Mr. Fasken's death, Celeste Fasken was
20 fortunate to find love a second time and married Gordon Marcum; and

21 WHEREAS, Throughout her life, this gracious woman enjoyed
22 flowers, art, and entertaining, as well as bridge, tennis, and

24 WHEREAS, An inspiration to all who knew her, Celeste Marcum

1 lived a caring and purposeful life, and those who were privileged to
2 share in the warmth of her affection will forever hold her close in
3 their hearts; now, therefore, be it
