2 of James William Daniel of Mount Pleasant, who died on March 9,
3 2007, at the age of 86; and

4 WHEREAS, Billy Daniel was born to Walker and Lura Norton
5 Daniel on February 22, 1921, in Texarkana; he served his country
6 with valor during World War II as a member of the United States Army
7 Air Force; and
