14 WHEREAS, Mr. Cloud had a long history of sharing his expertise and leadership with his professional community; a 15 longtime member and former president of the American Concrete 16 Paving Association, he served on the boards of the Texas State 17 Technological College Foundation and the Texas 18 Engineering Extension Service; in addition, he was a life member of the 19 Associated General Contractors of Texas, serving the organization 20 21 on the state level as president and on the national level as a 22 longtime committee chair; he earned the title of National Outstanding Committee Chairman in 1997; and 23
