H.C.R. No. 290

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 3249 has been adopted by the house of
2 representatives and the senate and is being prepared for
3 enrollment; and

4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
5 corrected; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED by the 80th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
7 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed
8 to make the following corrections:

9 Add the following appropriately numbered sections to Article
10 2 of the bill and renumber the subsequent sections of that article
11 accordingly:

12 SECTION 2.____. TEXAS BOARD OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND TEXAS
13 DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE. (a) Section 492.012, Government
14 Code, is amended to read as follows:

15 Sec. 492.012. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Board of
16 Criminal Justice and the Texas Department of Criminal Justice are
17 subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in
18 existence as provided by that chapter, the board and the department
19 are abolished September 1, 2009 [~~2007~~]. In the review of the board
20 and the department by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required
21 by this section, the sunset commission shall limit its review to the
22 appropriateness of recommendations made to the 80th Legislature.
23 In its report to the 81st Legislature, the sunset commission may
24 include any recommendations it considers appropriate.

1 (b) This section takes effect only if the 80th Legislature,
2 Regular Session, 2007, does not enact other legislation that
3 becomes law and that amends Section 492.012, Government Code, to
4 extend the sunset date of the Texas Board of Criminal Justice and
5 the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. If the 80th Legislature,
6 Regular Session, 2007, enacts legislation of that kind, this
7 section has no effect.

8 SECTION 2.____. CORRECTIONAL MANAGED HEALTH CARE COMMITTEE.
9 Section 501.132, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

10 Sec. 501.132. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Correctional
11 Managed Health Care Committee is subject to review under Chapter
12 325 (Texas Sunset Act) regarding the committee's role and
13 responsibilities. The committee shall be reviewed during the
14 period in which the Texas Department of Criminal Justice is
15 reviewed. [~~Unless continued in existence as provided by that~~
16 ~~chapter, the committee is abolished and this subchapter expires~~
17 ~~September 1, 2007.~~]
