CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, House Bill No. 3249 has been adopted by the house of
- 2 representatives and the senate and is being prepared for
- 3 enrollment; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The bill contains technical errors that should be
- 5 corrected; now, therefore, be it
- 6 RESOLVED by the 80th Legislature of the State of Texas, That
- 7 the enrolling clerk of the house of representatives be instructed
- 8 to make the following corrections:
- 9 Add the following appropriately numbered sections to Article
- 10 2 of the bill and renumber the subsequent sections of that article
- 11 accordingly:
- 12 SECTION 2.__. TEXAS BOARD OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE AND TEXAS
- 13 DEPARTMENT OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE. (a) Section 492.012, Government
- 14 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 492.012. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Board of
- 16 Criminal Justice and the Texas Department of Criminal Justice are
- 17 subject to Chapter 325 (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in
- 18 existence as provided by that chapter, the board and the department
- 19 are abolished September 1, 2009 [2007]. In the review of the board
- 20 and the department by the Sunset Advisory Commission, as required
- 21 by this section, the sunset commission shall limit its review to the
- 22 appropriateness of recommendations made to the 80th Legislature.
- 23 In its report to the 81st Legislature, the sunset commission may
- include any recommendations it considers appropriate.

- (b) This section takes effect only if the 80th Legislature, 1 Regular Session, 2007, does not enact other legislation that 2 becomes law and that amends Section 492.012, Government Code, to 3 4 extend the sunset date of the Texas Board of Criminal Justice and the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. If the 80th Legislature, 5 6 Regular Session, 2007, enacts legislation of that kind, this section has no effect. 7 SECTION 2.__. CORRECTIONAL MANAGED HEALTH CARE COMMITTEE. 8 Section 501.132, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 9
- Sec. 501.132. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Correctional 10 Managed Health Care Committee is subject to review under Chapter 11 325 (Texas Sunset Act) regarding the committee's role and 12 responsibilities. The committee shall be reviewed during the 13 period in which the Texas Department of Criminal Justice is 14 15 reviewed. [Unless continued in existence as provided by that chapter, the committee is abolished and this subchapter expires 16 17 September 1, 2007.
