A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the denial of bail
- 2 to a person who violates certain court orders or conditions of
- 3 release in a felony or family violence case.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article I, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 amending Section 11b and adding Section 11c to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11b. Any person who is accused in this state of a
- 8 felony or an offense involving family violence, [in this state] who
- 9 is released on bail pending trial, and whose bail is subsequently
- 10 revoked or forfeited for a violation of a condition of release may
- 11 be denied bail pending trial if [on a determination by] a [district]
- judge or magistrate in this state determines by a preponderance of
- 13 the evidence $[\tau]$ at a subsequent hearing $[to set or reinstate bail_{\tau}]$
- 14 that the person violated a condition of release related to the
- 15 safety of a victim of the alleged offense or to the safety of the
- 16 community.
- 17 Sec. 11c. The legislature by general law may provide that
- any person who violates an order for emergency protection issued by
- 19 <u>a judge or magistrate after an arrest for an offense involving</u>
- 20 <u>family violence or who violates an active protective order rendered</u>
- 21 by a court in a family violence case, including a temporary ex parte
- order that has been served on the person, or who engages in conduct
- 23 that constitutes an offense involving the violation of an order
- 24 described by this section may be taken into custody and, pending

- 1 trial or other court proceedings, denied release on bail if
- 2 following a hearing a judge or magistrate in this state determines
- 3 by a preponderance of the evidence that the person violated the
- 4 order or engaged in the conduct constituting the offense.
- 5 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 6 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007.
- 7 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 8 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the denial
- 9 of bail to a person who violates certain court orders or conditions
- of release in a felony or family violence case."
