A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to require the election of
- 2 the speaker of the house of representatives by a public vote
- 3 conducted by a roll call vote or electronic voting machine.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 9(b), Article III, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The House of Representatives shall, when it first
- 8 assembles, organize temporarily, and thereupon proceed to the
- 9 election of a Speaker from its own members. Notwithstanding
- 10 Section 41 of this article, the election must be by a public vote
- 11 conducted by a roll call with each member stating the member's
- 12 choice for Speaker or by an electronic voting machine that records
- each member's choice for Speaker.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to require the house of
- 18 representatives to elect the speaker of the house by a public vote
- 19 conducted by a roll call vote or an electronic voting machine."
