- 10 the confirmation of the recess appointees of the Governor, and

- 13 succeeding thirty days of the regular session of the Legislature
- 14 the various committees of each House shall hold hearings to
- 15 consider all bills and resolutions and other matters then pending;
- 16 and such emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor.
- 17 During the remainder of the session the Legislature shall act upon
- 18 [such] bills and resolutions [as may be then pending] and upon such
- 19 emergency matters as may be submitted by the Governor in special
- 20 messages to the Legislature. Bills and resolutions may be
- 21 <u>introduced at any time during the regular session and neither House</u>
- 22 may adopt a rule or take action under Subsection (c) of this section
- 23 <u>in a manner that imposes a deadline for the filing of bills or</u>
- 24 resolutions during the regular session. This subsection does not

- affect the authority of a House to permit the prefiling of bills or resolutions before the Legislature convenes in regular session.
- SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007. The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment allowing bills and resolutions to be introduced at any time during a regular session of the legislature."
