A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 28, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 28. No current wages for personal service shall ever
- 7 be subject to garnishment, except for the enforcement of
- 8 court-ordered:
- 9 (1) child support payments; [or]
- 10 (2) spousal maintenance; or
- 11 (3) restitution in a criminal judgment.
- 12 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 13 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007.
- 14 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 15 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing
- 16 garnishment of wages for court-ordered restitution in a criminal
- 17 judgment."
