## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to abolish the constitutional

- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 64, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 64. The [office of Inspector of Hides and Animals, the]
- 7 elective district, county, and precinct offices which have
- 8 heretofore had terms of two years, shall hereafter have terms of
- 9 four years; and the holders of such offices shall serve until their
- 10 successors are qualified.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 65(a), Article XVI, Texas Constitution,
- 12 is amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) This section applies to the following offices: District
- 14 Clerks; County Clerks; County Judges; Judges of the County Courts
- 15 at Law, County Criminal Courts, County Probate Courts and County
- 16 Domestic Relations Courts; County Treasurers; Criminal District
- 17 Attorneys; County Surveyors; [Inspectors of Hides and Animals;]
- 18 County Commissioners; Justices of the Peace; Sheriffs; Assessors
- 19 and Collectors of Taxes; District Attorneys; County Attorneys;
- 20 Public Weighers; and Constables.
- 21 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007.
- 23 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 24 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to abolish the
