A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment to allow a member of the 1 2 legislature to designate a successor to serve in case of the 3 member's death or incapacity to serve. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by 5 adding Section 13A to read as follows: 6 Sec. 13A. (a) A member of the legislature in a signed 7 document filed with the presiding officer of the appropriate house 8 9 may designate a person to serve as the member's successor for the remainder of the member's term if the member dies or becomes 10 11 incapacitated to the extent that the member can no longer serve in 12 office. (b) To be eligible to serve as a successor a person must: 13 14 (1) belong to the same political party as the member being replaced; and 15 16 (2) meet the other eligibility requirements of this constitution for the office of representative or senator, as 17 18 appropriate. (c) Following the death or incapacity of a member who has 19 made a designation under this section, a person designated as the 20 21 member's successor who meets the requirements of Subsection (b) of 22 this section: 23 (1) is entitled to take the constitutional oath of office and to serve the remainder of the term of the member making 24

1 the designation; and 2 (2) has all the powers, privileges, and duties of 3 office as the member making the designation. 4 (d) Each house shall adopt rules as necessary to implement this section, including rules defining the circumstances under 5 6 which a member is incapacitated to the extent that the member can no 7 longer serve in office. 8 (e) Notwithstanding Section 13 of this article, a vacancy requiring an election does not occur in the office of a member of 9 the legislature if the member's designated successor under this 10 section takes office on or before the 21st day after the date the 11 12 member dies or is determined incapacitated. SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 13 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007. 15 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment to allow a member of the 16 legislature to designate a successor to serve for the remainder of 17

18 the term of office in case of the member's death or incapacity to 19 serve."
