A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to require each house of the
- 2 legislature to take a record vote on final passage of a bill or
- 3 proposed constitutional amendment.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12. <u>(a)</u> Each <u>house of the legislature</u> [House] shall
- 8 keep a journal of its proceedings, and publish the same.
- 9 (b) A vote taken by either house must be by record vote with
- 10 the vote of each member entered in the journal of that house if the
- 11 vote is on final passage of a bill or of a measure proposing an
- 12 <u>amendment to this constitution</u>; and the yeas and nays of the members
- of either house [House] on any other question shall, at the desire
- 14 of any three members present, be entered on the journals. For
- 15 purposes of this subsection, a vote on final passage includes a vote
- on third reading in a house or on second reading if the house
- 17 suspends the requirement for three readings, on whether to concur
- 18 <u>in the other house's amendments</u>, and on whether to adopt a
- conference committee report.
- 20 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007.
- 22 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 23 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to require that a
- 24 record vote be taken by a house of the legislature on final passage

of any bill or proposed constitutional amendment."
