## A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment to change the length of the unexpired term that causes the automatic resignation of certain elected county or district officeholders if they become candidates for another office.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 65(b), Article XVI, Texas Constitution,
7 is amended to read as follows:

(b) If any of the officers named herein shall announce their 8 candidacy, or shall in fact become a candidate, in any General, 9 Special or Primary Election, for any office of profit or trust under 10 the laws of this State or the United States other than the office 11 12 then held, at any time when the unexpired term of the office then held shall exceed one [(1)] year and 60 days, such announcement or 13 14 such candidacy shall constitute an automatic resignation of the office then held, and the vacancy thereby created shall be filled 15 pursuant to law in the same manner as other vacancies for such 16 office are filled. 17

SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007. The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the proposition: "The constitutional amendment to change the length of the unexpired term that causes the automatic resignation of certain elected county or district officeholders if they become candidates for another office."
