## A JOINT RESOLUTION

proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature to permit the governing body of a political subdivision that imposes ad valorem taxes on real property in Harris County, other than a school district or junior college district, to establish a limitation of not less than five percent on the maximum average annual increase in the appraised value of residence homesteads for ad valorem taxation by the political subdivision.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

9 SECTION 1. Section 1, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is 10 amended by adding Subsection (i-1) to read as follows:

11 (i-1) Notwithstanding Subsections (a), (b), and (i) of this 12 section, the Legislature by general law may authorize the governing body of a political subdivision that imposes ad valorem taxes on 13 14 real property in Harris County, other than a school district or junior college district, to establish for purposes of ad valorem 15 16 taxation by the political subdivision a limitation on the maximum average annual percentage increase in the appraised value of 17 18 residence homesteads of not less than five percent. A limitation on increases in appraised value established under this subsection 19 takes effect and expires in the manner provided by Subsection (i) of 20 21 this section. If the governing body of a political subdivision establishes a limitation on increases in appraised value under this 22 23 subsection applicable to a tax year for which the legislature has enacted a limitation on increases in appraised value authorized by 24

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Subsection (i) of this section, the lower percentage limitation 1 2 applies to ad valorem taxation by the political subdivision. If the governing body of a political subdivision, other than a school 3 4 district or junior college district, establishes a limitation on increases in appraised value under this subsection, the limitation 5 6 remains in effect until amended or repealed by the governing body of 7 the political subdivision. 8 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be

9 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 6, 2007.
