A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for open meetings of
- 2 each House of the Legislature, and its committees and
- 3 subcommittees.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 16, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 16 (a) The sessions of each House shall be open, except
- 8 the Senate when in Executive session.
- 9 <u>(b) The Legislature by general law may administer and</u> 10 <u>enforce the requirement of Subsection (a) of this section.</u>
- 11 (c) All meetings of every committee of each House at which
- official acts are to be taken or at which public business is to be
- 13 transacted or discussed shall be open and noticed to the public and
- 14 meetings of the legislature shall be open and noticed as provided in
- 15 Article III, Section 4(e), except with respect to meetings exempted
- 16 pursuant to this section or specifically closed by this
- 17 Constitution. The Legislature may provide by general law, passed by
- 18 <u>a two-thirds vote of each House, for the exemption of meetings from</u>
- 19 the requirements of this section, provided that such law shall
- 20 state with specificity the public necessity justifying the
- 21 <u>exemption</u> and shall be no broader than necessary to accomplish the
- 22 stated purpose of the law. As used in this section, the term
- 23 "committee" means any committee created by or under the authority
- 24 of a House, its presiding officer, or other officer granted that

- 1 <u>authority by the rules of that House to create a committee, and</u>
- 2 <u>includes working groups.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 4 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 8, 2007.
- 5 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 6 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for open
- 7 meetings of each House of the Legislature, and its committees and
- 8 subcommittees."
