RESOLUTION

- BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
- 2 Texas, That, in accordance with Sections 9(b) and 11, Article III,
- 3 Texas Constitution, the House of Representatives of the 80th
- 4 Legislature shall elect a speaker of the house from its own
- 5 membership as follows:
- 6 SECTION 1. NOMINATIONS. (a) The secretary of state shall
- 7 call for nominations from the floor for the election of speaker of
- 8 the house of representatives and shall recognize every member who
- 9 desires to make a nomination. The order in which members desiring
- 10 to make a nomination shall proceed shall be determined by lot.
- 11 (b) Each member recognized for this purpose shall
- immediately advance to the front microphone and make the nomination
- in a nominating speech not to exceed five minutes in length.
- 14 (c) After all nominations have been made, the secretary of
- 15 state shall declare nominations to be closed.
- 16 SECTION 2. SECONDS. (a) A person is not considered a
- 17 nominee unless the nomination is seconded by at least one member.
- 18 (b) One seconding speech shall be allowed for each
- 19 nomination in the order in which nominations were made, then other
- 20 seconding speeches shall be allowed in rotation in the same order.
- (c) No more than five seconding speeches shall be allowed
- 22 for each nominee.
