18 WHEREAS, She married Roy Laughton Whitehead in 1933 and the 19 couple moved to Longview, where Mrs. Whitehead devoted herself to 20 maintaining the family's home and raising their two children, 21 Barbara Ann and Laughton; in the years since then, the family has 22 grown to include Barbara's husband, Donald Joe Kiser, and 23 Laughton's wife, the former Martha Frances Hess, six grandchildren, 24 Donald and his wife, Mary Beth, Sara and her husband, Jerry, Julie
