

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, With great sorrow, the family and friends of
2 longtime Del Rio resident Libbie Stool mourn the loss of this
3 committed community leader, who died in San Antonio on September 6,
4 2006, at the age of 79; and

5 WHEREAS, Libbie Stool and her husband, Max, lived most of
6 their married life in Del Rio, where Mrs. Stool took an active role
7 in a number of civic activities and organizations; she was the
8 president of the Val Verde County Library Board when the new library
9 was constructed and a founding member of the Pan American Round
10 Table, a women's organization that promotes understanding among the
11 peoples of the Western Hemisphere; a caring parent, she became
12 involved in a variety of school and youth organizations, including
13 4-H and the PTA; as a member of the Val Verde Friends of the Arts,
14 she aided in the group's successful effort to purchase a new
15 Steinway grand piano for public performances; and

16 WHEREAS, With an intense interest in the events of her state
17 and nation, Mrs. Stool took part in social and political causes,
18 becoming a co-founder of a local family planning organization and
19 acting as the Val Verde County co-chair for the Texas gubernatorial
20 campaign of Ann Richards; and

21 WHEREAS, A member of the National Council for Jewish Women,
22 Mrs. Stool will also be remembered for her commitment to her Jewish
23 heritage and faith; her family and friends may take further comfort
24 in the memory of her good humor and her keen intellect and in the

1 knowledge that this caring advocate for her community has left a
2 lasting legacy of passion and commitment that all may admire; now,
3 therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Libbie Stool and
6 extend sincere condolences to the members of her family: to her
7 husband of 59 years, Max Stool; to their children, Ethan Stool and
8 his wife, Patti, Ben L. Stool and his wife, Michele Ritter, and
9 Elizabeth Friedman and her husband, David; to her grandchildren,
10 Justin and Rebekah Stool and Samuel, Asher, Sydney, and Rachel
11 Friedman; and to her other relatives and friends; and, be it further
