3 18, 2007; and

4           WHEREAS, Better known simply as Tet, this annual event ushers

6 Vietnamese; this year's observance marks the commencement of the  
7 year of the pig, a period in which bearing children is considered  
8 auspicious; and

9           WHEREAS, Tet begins on the first day of the first lunar month  
10 of the year and falls between the end of January and the middle of  
11 February; while the exact date of the New Year changes from year to  
12 year, the festive spirit of the season remains the same; and

13           WHEREAS, The eve of the holiday's three-day festival is spent  
14 cleaning homes and ancestral graves and preparing a ceremonial  
15 meal; the New Year traditionally serves as a time to reunite with  
16 family, renew special friendships, and remember past experiences,  
17 paving the way for good things to come; and

18           WHEREAS, The Vietnamese community of Texas plays a vital role  
19 in the business, professional, and cultural life of the state, and  
20 Tet Nguyen Dan provides a fitting opportunity to salute these fine  
21 citizens on this special occasion and to celebrate our common goals  
22 of peace and harmony for all humanity; now, therefore, be it
