WHEREAS, Mr. Thomas joined the staff of the LCRA as an apprentice and steadily rose through the ranks to become an irrigation coordinator and, ultimately, a crew leader in the Lakeside Irrigation District; he managed the seven-member staff of the Lakeside canal system and operated a section of the canal; and

WHEREAS, A hard-working family man, Mr. Thomas was passionate about contributing to the betterment of his community and often sought out volunteer opportunities; notably, he was the first African American to volunteer with the Eagle Lake Fire Department; and
