

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Residents of Eagle Pass and Maverick County are  
2 gathering at the State Capitol on January 31, 2007, to celebrate the  
3 contributions of their region to the Lone Star State; and

4           WHEREAS, Maverick County was named for Samuel Augustus  
5 Maverick in 1856, and its county seat, Eagle Pass, is located on the  
6 border between Mexico and Texas; originally named El Paso del  
7 Aguila because of the frequent flights of Mexican eagles over the  
8 area, the county seat was settled during the middle of the 19th  
9 century and has a unique history as a gateway to Texas from Mexico;

11           WHEREAS, A favorite of tourists from across the state, Eagle  
12 Pass and Maverick County are home to several historically  
13 significant sites, including Fort Duncan Park and San Juan Plaza;  
14 outdoor recreational activities abound at Maverick County Lake, and  
15 nearby Piedras Negras offers residents and tourists alike the  
16 opportunity to experience the charm of Mexico firsthand; and

17           WHEREAS, As a center for industry, commerce, tourism, and  
18 recreation, Maverick County and Eagle Pass occupy an enviable  
19 position in South Texas; both city and county governments are  
20 committed to the expansion and development of the region's many  
21 resources, including local infrastructure improvements,  
22 construction of an international trade and convention center, and  
23 preservation of historic sites; and
