he went on to serve as an air weapons systems training officer, as

advisor to the Secretary of the Navy before becoming commanding

officer of aircraft repair and overhaul facilities in Florida and

California; he remained in the U.S. Navy Reserve until retiring

with the rank of captain at the age of 60; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hunt moved to the private sector in 1959, when he

21 took over supervision of the American Airlines engineering and

maintenance depot in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and pioneered computer use

23 for recordkeeping in the airline and defense industries; later, he

24 took charge of American Flyers and BWIA airlines before being

- 6 Oklahoma properties; he retired from that enterprise at the age of

- 9 63 wonderful years of marriage, he lives today near his son and
- 10 daughter-in-law, Jack and Diane Hunt, in the Bayou City and takes
- 11 pleasure in the company of his grandchildren, Laura, Lisa, and
- 12 Helen, and his great-grandchildren, Charlotte and Luke; and
