

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, David Cole Pullig of Boy Scouts of America Troop No.
2 437 has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this accomplishment
3 truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
7 criteria, Mr. Pullig earned the requisite 21 merit badges and
8 successfully completed an Eagle Scout project of benefit to his
9 community; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Pullig has been active in numerous school and
11 community activities; in addition to his eight years in the Boy
12 Scouts, he has played varsity football, served as referee for YMCA
13 youth football and soccer contests, and participated on the social
14 studies team; notably, his hard work and dedication have earned him
15 a congressional nomination to attend the United States Military
16 Academy at West Point; and

17 WHEREAS, The president and cofounder of Teenage Republican of
18 Denton County, Mr. Pullig attended the 2006 Boys State, where he
19 was elected committee chairman; he also participated in the 2005
20 National Student Leadership in Washington, D.C., and won two essay
21 contests; moreover, David Pullig was a valuable volunteer for State
22 Representative Tan Parker's election campaign; and

23 WHEREAS, This fine young Texan has demonstrated outstanding
24 leadership ability throughout his scouting career, winning the

1 respect and admiration of his fellow scouts as he worked toward the
2 highest rank that scouting offers; and

3 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Pullig's dedication to excellence and
4 his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy
5 to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with
6 pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 80th Texas
8 Legislature hereby honor David Cole Pullig for earning the rank of
9 Eagle Scout and extend to him best wishes for continued success;
10 and, be it further

11 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
12 prepared for Mr. Pullig as an expression of high regard by the Texas
13 House of Representatives.
