WHEREAS, He performed his duties with great distinction 16 during his tenure in the Marine Corps, earning promotion to the rank 17 18 of sergeant as well as the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, and a National Defense 19 Service Medal, to name but a few; despite the dangerous nature of 20 21 his mission, he remained devoted to serving his country and was intensely proud of the role he was playing in the Global War on 22 23 Terrorism; and
